Exceptional and Temporary Measures of health surveillance in response to Pandemic of Covid-19 Disease

Due to the Pandemic spread all over the world caused by COVID-19 disease and its variants, Timor-Leste continues to take exceptional and temporary measures in order to prevent the contagious of the Covid19 virus.

Therefore some rules provide for in the Decree-Law nr. 26/2021, of 26th November as well as in the Ministry of Health's diplomas nr. 82/2021, 83/2021, and 84/2021 of 9th December, need to be highlighted, namely those that refer to international movements of passengers, crew members, oil sector workers as well as land border schedules and the validity of licences and documents:

Legal framework: Decree-Law 26/2021, 26th November and Ministry of Health's Diplomas nr. 82/2021, 83/2021, and 84/2021, of 9th December

- **Obligatory of health control**
 1. Passengers intending to enter or leave national territory are obligatorily subject to health control under the terms of the international Health regulations;
 2. Passenger must have a negative COVID-19 PCR test result made at most 5 days before arrival;
 3. Crew members (air, maritime and land transportation) and oil sector workers must have full vaccination certificate and negative COVID-19 PCR test result valid for 72 hours;
- **Opening hours of land border posts**
 1. Land Border Posts of **Batugade, Salele (Suai), Sakato** and **Oesilo** will only open as follows:
 - a. **Monday** - from **09:00 a.m. to 15:00 (TLT)** – **Exit** of persons and goods are allowed;
 - b. **Wednesday** - - from **09:00 a.m. to 15:00 (TLT)** – **Entry** of persons and goods are allowed;
- **Licenses and authorisations**
 1. Licenses and authorizations and other administrative acts and documents remain valid until **31st January 2022**;
 2. The provisions of the previous number do not apply to the validity periods resulting from the application of the international agreement or of a law approved in the exercise of absolute reserve of legislative competence of the National Parliament.
